

The Penguin

A toy with a pocket

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Is anybody out there who wouldn't be happy meeting a little friend? Especially if this friend has a little surprise with him – what a joy is that!!!
Introducing you to this cute little Penguin, who is a toy and a pocket at the same time.
You can put something yummy inside his tummy... like a sweet treat, or a gum!!!
Or you could put a piece of soap there, and your penguin would smell really good.
Or... how about a love letter? You see, this penguin can be extremely useful!

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

Materials:

Acrylic yarn Red Heart Super Saver – black (312) , white (311), and a bit of red (319) and yellow

3-4 mm hook

2 black beads



Body:

With black yarn, ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: (2 sc in each sc) around – 12 sc

Row2: (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 18 sc

Row3: (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 24 sc

Row4: (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 30 sc

Row5: (sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 36 sc

Row6-16: sc around – 36 sc



Head:

With black yarn, ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.

Row1: (2 sc in each sc) around – 12 sc

Row2: (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 18 sc

Row3: (sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 24 sc

Row4: (sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 30 sc

Row5: (sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 36 sc

Row6-10: sc around – 36 sc

Breast:

With white yarn, ch 8 + 1 (*turning ch*)

Row 1: 3 sc in the 2nd ch from hook, 6 sc, 3 sc into the next ch, *turn to the other side of ch*, 6 sc – 18 sc

Row 2: (2 sc in each of next 3 sc, 6 sc) repeat – 24 sc

Row 3: [(1 sc, 2 sc in next sc) x 3 times, 6 sc] repeat – 30 sc



Wing (*make four parts - two white and two black*)

Ch 4 + 1, turn and continue working flat rows (not round)

Row1-10: sc to the end – 4 sc

Row11: skip the first sc – 3 sc

Row12: skip the first sc – 2 sc

Assembling: sew a black part onto a white one (or join them as seen at the picture)



Beak (*make two equal parts*)

Ch 3 + 1, turn and continue working flat rows

Row1: sc to the end – 3 sc

Row2: skip the second sc – 2 sc

Row3: two sc together – 1 sc

Legs

Ch 3 + 1, turn and continue working flat rows

Row1-2: sc to the end – 3 sc

Row3: 2 sc in each sc – 6 sc

Row4: sc to the end – 6 sc

Work a row of sc around the edge



Eyes:

Whites: Ch 4, join to form a ring. 6 sc into the ring.
Pupils: use black beads



Assembling:

1. Attach the head to the body leaving an opening (approximately 1/3 of an overall length).
2. Attach the wings to the neck part of the body.
3. Finish the face, attaching the eyes and the beak in place, and embroidering the eyebrows.
4. Attach the legs and the breast to the body.
